

FCJ WINS 5 AWARDS AT THE GRETA BOGUES CORPORATE GOVERNANCE AWARDS FOR EXCELLENCE



Factories Corporation of Jamaica Limited continues to excel in corporate governance outperforming over 100 public bodies. FCJ has been placed 2nd overall in the 2020/21 Greta Bogues Corporate Governance Awards for Excellence, which is a collaboration between the Private Sector Organisation of Jamaica and the Ministry of Finance and Public service.

At the recently held awards ceremony, FCJ was announced a winner in five (5) categories. FCJ continues to dominate the Best Website category, having been named the winner for two (2) consecutive years. Another major accomplishment is being placed 2nd for two consecutive years for Best Annual Report.

FCJ secured two (2) additional awards by placing third in the categories of Governance Award for Board Composition, Function and Structure and Risk Measurement, Management and Internal Controls.

The Public Bodies Corporate Governance Awards which is in its fourth staging was renamed the Greta Bogues Corporate

Governance Awards for Excellence in honour of the the late Greta Bogues, former interim CEO of the PSOJ, who was instrumental in developing these awards and corporate governance guidelines.



The Greta Bagues Corporate Governance Awards for Excellence recognise distinction in corporate governance practices in public entities. These awards are issued in four (4) traditional categories: Board Composition, Function & Structure; Corporate Governance Policies, Procedures and Practices; Compliance & Disclosure of Information and Risk Measurement, Management & Internal Controls. Special awards were also given for: Best Annual Report, Best Website and Most Improved Public Body.

Among the top entrants in this years staging, were the Development Bank of Jamaica (DBJ), Jamaica Mortgage Bank (JMB), EXIM Bank, National Solid Waste Management Authority (NSWA), National Housing Trust, Jamaica Mortgage Bank and National Health Fund (NHF). The National Health Fund emerged the overall winner and the NSWMA, JMB, DBJ and NHT were also named category winners.
